NURSING ASSISTANT or LICENSED PRACTICAL NURSE



Licensed Practical Nurses offer care to patients and work with Registered Nurses, Doctors and other healthcare professionals to provide various prescribed treatments and help patients with their personal hygiene and comfort.



Salary: \$20,28 – \$26,63 per hour



Certification: Health Assistance and Nursing
2 year program (1800 hours).



Pre-requisites: High School Diploma with Grade 11 French and English and Grade 10 math.



NURSING ATTENDANT or ORDERLY



Nursing Attendants and/or Orderlies provide basic care and physical assistance to patients, helping them wash, dress, and eat as part of their health recovery and maintenance, primarily in hospital and long-term care settings.



Salary: \$18,67 – \$20,49 per hour



Certification: Assistance in Health Care Facilities
One year program (750 hours).



Pre-requisites: High School Diploma with Grade 9 English, French and Math.

HOME CARE ATTENDANT



Home Care Attendants or Client Care Attendants provide basic care and services in various settings to individuals with illnesses or physical/mental disabilities including support for safely performing everyday activities, intervention in crisis or emergency situations.



Salary: \$18,71 – \$20,54 per hour



Certification: Home Care Assistance
One year program (975 hours).



Pre-requisites: High School Diploma with Grade 9 English, French and Math.

REGISTERED NURSE (RN)



An RN assesses individual health and, in collaboration with other health professionals, determines and provides nursing care and treatment such as taking vital signs, bandaging wounds, controlling infections, and monitoring nutrition.



Salary: \$20.86 – \$30.03 per hour



Certification: CEGEP diploma, Nursing Program (3 years). Must pass College of Nurses of Quebec Professional exam.



Pre-requisites: High School Diploma, including Grade 10 Cultural Math, Science (Physical Science STE or SE 436) and Grade 11 Chemistry 534.



NURSE PRACTITIONER (SPECIALIZED)



While active in many aspects of care, treatment, health education, and nursing research, nurse practitioners – as specialists – must also receive training in one of the following: neonatology, nephrology, cardiology, or primary care.



Salary: \$28.17 – \$50.23 per hour



Certification: University, Bachelor of Nursing (2 years). Must pass College of Nurses of Quebec Professional exam.



Pre-requisites: CEGEP diploma, Nursing Program (3 years).

NURSE CLINICIANS



Nurse clinicians assess patients for appropriate nursing interventions and administer prescribed medications and treatments. They may supervise licensed practical nurses or other nursing staff, and have the opportunity to specialize from a wide selection of medical fields of practice.



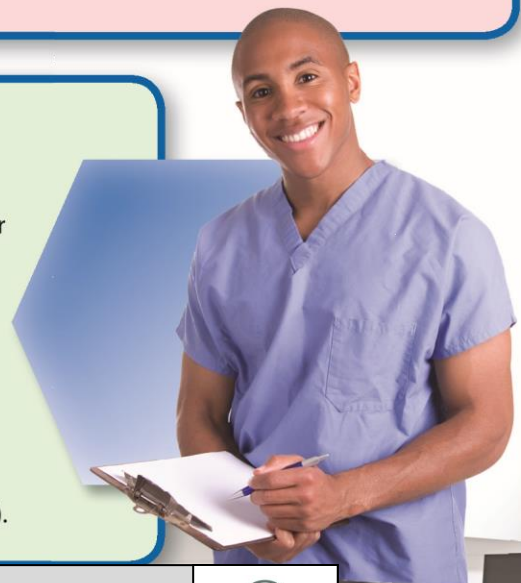
